

# BURN-BIN

Due to regular complaints from our neighbours, and plot holders, about smoke from bonfires, but with the clear need to dispose of a significant amount of non-compostable plant waste, such as blighted potato haulms, or tomato stems, sweet corn stalks, fruit bush and tree cuttings etc. we have set up a large Burn-Bin / Incinerator in the centre of the Burnside site. This is to reduce the number of bonfires on the site and help those with smaller plots, who don't have room for a fire, to be able to dispose of this waste. Also the design of the Burn-Bin and the inclusion of additional timber when in use, results in a very hot fast burning fire, with far less smoke.

## Use of the Burn-Bin is as follows.

- Regular weekend burns will be managed by one of the site management team. **DO NOT** use the Burn-Bin at any other time.
- The Burn-Bin will be lit from mid-morning Saturday and or Sunday depending on demand.
- The Burn-Bin will not be lit if the wind is in the wrong direction, or if it is too wet. See the web site calendar for proposed dates and a couple of days before for possible cancellations and exact timings.
- Your waste will go straight into the lit Burn-Bin when you bring it to the burn area. You can come and borrow a wheel barrow if you don't have one.
- **DO NOT dump your waste near, or in, the Burn-Bin at any other time!**
- Please allow your waste to dry out for a week or so on your plot before bringing it round to the Burn-Bin.
- Any scrap timber can be added to the timber pile at any time.
- Scrap timber must not be removed from the Burn-Bin wood pile.
